Prof. Dr. phil. Lauren Clack is a Professor of Implementation Science in Health Care at the Medical Faculty, University of Zurich and the Division of Infectious Diseases, University Hospital Zurich. She holds a PhD in Psychology from the University of Zurich and an MSc in Applied Ergonomics (Human Factors Engineering) from the University of Nottingham. Her research group is dedicated to the development and application of implementation science methodology to improve the user-centered design and integration of evidence-based practices into care – with a particular focus on infection prevention and patient safety interventions.
